Torres Strait Islander cultural presentations - Eddie Peters

Workshops will be presented by Torres Strait Islander musician and dancer Eddie Peters. Comprising of cultural information, story, songs and dance, Eddie's sessions include teaching his audience movements for certain dances, and a Torres Strait Islander song. Approximately 45 minutes per session.

These sessions comprise of historical, cultural, and geographical information about Aboriginal Australia, with general information regarding certain political and social issues, including the Stolen Generations.
